sequela A sequel Any condition or state that follows a disease, disorder, or injury, especially one that is a consequence of it A COMPLICATIONThe term is most often used in the plural form-sequelae

CEREBROVASCULAR DISEASE SEQUELA • Identify the deficit such as aphasia, dysphagia, monoplegia, hemiparesis • Determine if dominant or non-dominant side is affected for hemiplegia/monoplegia cases • Inquire about any alcohol, drug or tobacco use, abuse or dependence • Identify tobacco exposure (eg, second hand, occupational, etc)

ICD-10-CM Coding Tip Sequela (Late Effects)

A sequela is the residual effect (condition produced) after the acute phase of an illness or injury has terminated In ICD-10-CM, the term "late effect" has been replaced with sequela There is no time limit on when a sequela code can be used

Chronic Sequelae of Ankle Sprains - AkuTel

tibia This is often seen after a classic inversion sprain This can also be a sequela of the high ankle sprain, usually caused by dorsiflexion combined with external rotation of the foot This is a less common sprain and involves the opposite motion, eversion An

Coding for ICD-10-CM: More of the Basics

A sequela is the residual effect, or condition produced, after the acute phase of an illness or injury has terminated. It is not the same as an acute complication, such as a wound infection. The most typical example of sequela is scar formation after a burn. When using 7th character "S", it is necessary to use both the injury code that

(Sequela of cerebrovascular disease is an exception) Example: treatment of ankle instability following a sprain: M24271 - Disorder of ligament, right ankle S93411S - Sprain of calcaneofibular lig, right ankle, sequela S93411S is not accepted as a primary diagnosis because instructions require

Chronic Sequelae of Foodborne Disease
